

## DIRECTIONS TO CAMP

Find your way to Osage Beach, Missouri. The park is off highway 42/134E leaving Osage Beach toward Brumley. If coming west, pass Brumley. The park entrance is highway 134.

### IN THE PARK:

Turn off Hwy 42 on to 134 (park entrance). There's a big map on the right. Take 134 to the second log cabin and turn right on Whispering Oaks Road and follow the OGC (meaning Organized Group Camps) signs. Watch for 'Camp Clover Point' signs which will take you into camp (7 miles from the main entrance). We are listed as Midwest Women's Festival.

### FEES

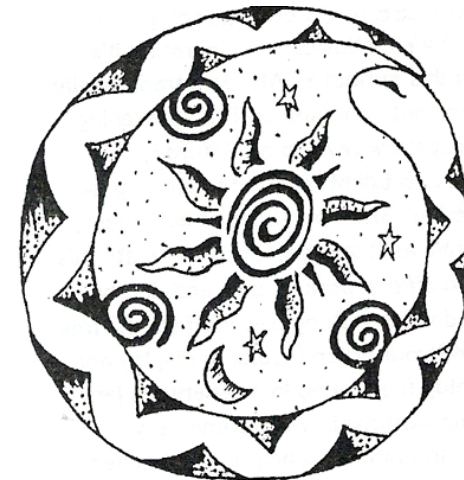
